Both schools are allowed to hold up to 20 students; currently Franklin has six children enrolled and Jefferson has eight children enrolled. There are 11 prospective students for Sunnyside and the conditional use permit is asking for up to 65 children to be allowed since the Summer Day Camp would be held at that location. YMCA collaborates with Parks and Recreation for summer activities, so there will not be a conflict of interest.
