NOTICE TO RESIDENTS AND NEIGHBORS OF ACCELERATED STREETS RESURFACING 2017

The City of Pullman has contracted with Motley-Motley, Inc. of Pullman, Washington to reconstruct the water main on High Street from Paradise Street to Dexter Street and sanitary sewer and storm sewer spot repairs on High and Pine Streets. This project will involve removing concrete pavement, excavating for and placing the new water main, and filling the trench with crushed rock. In some areas, existing sidewalks and curbs at driveways will be reconstructed; this is being done in preparation for street paving that will occur later this summer under this contract.

The following street sections will be reconstructed under the City's Extraordinary Street Maintenance Program this year. Work is scheduled to begin on or about August 28, 2017, and be completed by November 3, 2017.

High Street from Paradise to Dexter
McKenzie Street from High Street to Spring Street
Pine Street from McKenzie Street to Paradise Street

Streets will be closed to through traffic during work hours. Local traffic will be accommodated whenever possible. During construction, roads will be gravel surfaced and rough and residents should anticipate some delays. Please limit your speed and the number of trips you make, if possible.
