As always, thank you for your continued support of Pullman Parks & Recreation. Have a safe summer and we look forward to seeing everyone in one of our many programs.

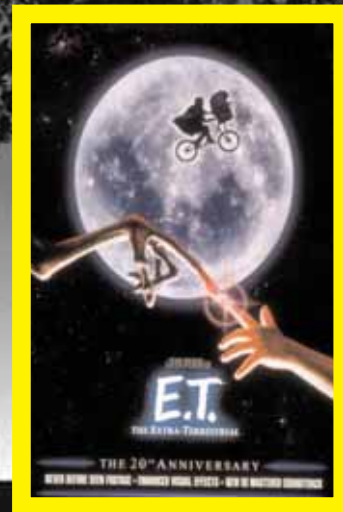
