The Pullman ArtWalk is a community festival of art for the whole family! This annual partnership between regional artists and local businesses celebrate the arts of the greater Palouse region. Stroll through innovative and interactive art exhibits, participate in children's activities, and revel in performing arts. Art-Walk is a celebration of community through arts!

The 2016 Project led by the **Pullman Arts Commission** hosted **37 artists** with works on display at **24 sites**. The event kicked off with presentation of the Mayor's Award Reception honoring Anna Maria Shannon, for her outstanding contribution to the arts, followed by the unveiling of the City's first ever Art-Wrapped **Utility Box**. **714 attendees** enjoyed this event, drawing **175 tourists** to the area booking **38** hotel nights in Pullman. **Community participation** increased by **20%**. The Saturday Main Event featured **Ken Carper**, whose art is showcased on the utility box, and new exhibits including a pop-up tape mural outside of Poppy Salon and art by students of all grades in the Pullman School District, on display in the Pullman City Hall Garage. **18 volunteers donated** over **200 hours** to make this year's event a success.
