





The **Pullman ArtWalk** is a family friendly festival celebrating arts, commerce, and community!

The City of Pullman Arts Commission cultivates the visual and performing arts to enrich the quality of life of the community through its vision, advocacy, and financial support, connecting residents, students, and visitors to diverse aesthetic and cultural experiences. It's commissioners are dedicated volunteers committed to nurturing art in all its brilliant forms.

ArtWalk 2018 featured over **45 artists** with exhibited works at **27 host businesses**.

**2,319 attendees** (292% increase) enjoyed exciting events over three days, drawing **150 tourists**

to the area who booked **34** paid nights of lodging (35% increase) in Pullman. This was a wonderful celebration of Pullman's 100th birthday.

Popular attractions included the **Mayor's Art Award** to Gail Siegel honoring her outstanding contribution to the performing arts, the inaugural **Olsen Street Fair**, the **Pullman School District Student Exhibit** at city hall, and the **Kid's Art Studio** and **Paint a Kindness Rock workshops** at Neill Public Library.

**16 volunteers donated** over **436 hours** (70% increase) to make ArtFest a success. This event was made possible thanks to grants from the Lodging & Tourism Tax Fund and Inland Northwest Broadcasting Community Partnership.
