



Pullman ArtFest is a family friendly festival celebrating arts, commerce and community, hosted by the City of Pullman Arts Commission. The Commission cultivates the visual and performing arts to enrich the quality of life of the community through its vision, advocacy, and financial support, connecting residents, students, and visitors to diverse aesthetic and cultural experiences. The Commission is a 7-member volunteer group.

ArtFest puts the “art” in party! This year’s event showcased works from over 57 hosted artists at 25 locations and a street fair featuring 13 nonprofits, 3 food vendors, 1 beer garden and 5 music groups. This is a **17% increase** in participation over last year.

Of the 2,073 people who attended ArtFest, 49% or 1,018 people provided **tourism information**. Of these respondents, 218 people traveled from outside of Pullman with the following breakdown.

- 14 people traveled between 7—49 miles away (585% decrease)
- 74 people traveled from 50+ miles away (37% increase)
- 130 people traveled from another state or country (622% increase)
- 54 people stayed overnight (200% increase); 12 people paid for 31 nights of lodging (8% decrease).

Community investment: 29 volunteers donated **478 hours** (10% increase) to make ArtFest a success. This event was made possible thanks to **financial support** from the Lodging & Tourism Tax Fund, Avista Utilities and Kiwanis Club of Pullman.
